



**Impacting Orphanages with Kids Against Hunger
Samaritan's Purse- PROJECT SANTIAGO 2006
HONDURAS**

Project Santiago began in July 2005 with 3 orphanages, and now covers 8 orphanages and 500 children in three different cities in the country. We have also received requests from other orphanages in the South for support as the word spreads of our aid. We cover the 3 largest cities in Honduras, where consequently, the highest number of orphans live. They are: San Pedro Sula with 144 kids, Tegucigalpa with 235 and La Ceiba with 60 kids. One of the main ways we have aided these orphanages is with food. Without the support of Kids Against Hunger, our program would be much less effective.
